Practice	<p>The local educational agency (LEA) must ensure that:</p> <p>Citations: 300.323(d) 89.1075(de)</p>
Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The child's IEP is accessible to each teacher who provides instruction to a child with disabilities regular education teacher, special education teacher, related services provider, and any other service provider who is responsible for its implementation; <u>• each teacher who provides instruction to a student with disabilities has access to relevant sections of the student's current IEP;</u> <p>Citations: 300.323(d)(1) 89.1075(de)(1)</p>
Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each teacher who provides instruction to a child with disabilities and provider described in this framework is informed of: <p>Citations: 300.323(d)(2) 89.1075(de)(2)</p>
Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The teacher's or provider's specific responsibilities related to implementing the child's IEP, <u>such as goals and objectives</u>; and <p>Citations: 300.323(d)(2)(i) 89.1075(d)(2e)(2)</p>
Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The specific <u>of needed</u> accommodations, modifications, and supports that must be provided for the child in accordance with the IEP; and <p>Citations: 300.323(d)(2)(ii) 89.1075(d)(2e)(2)</p>
Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each teacher who provides instruction to the child <u>with disabilities</u> has an opportunity to request assistance regarding implementation of the IEP.

	The LEA must develop a process to be used by a teacher who instructs a child with a disability in a regular classroom setting:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> That provides for a timely LEA response to the teacher's request; and
